THE PRESIDENT'S SADE

First, I want to extend a special thank you to all that participated in the annual Ride of Silence, this year held on May 15th. In the neighborhood of 45 cyclists turned up for the 12th edition of the Evansville event, which made quite the statement as the group rolled through the near east side of Evansville.

This year was extra special as family and friends of the late Buzz Latham joined in the ride. You might recall, Buzz was fatally injured on June 20, 2023, when hit by a motorist while riding his bicycle. Buzz wasn't yet a member of the EBC, but he was a member of our cherished cycling community. I know we would have loved to have him. It was an honor to ride for Buzz this year, as well as all those injured or killed due to an incident with a motorist.

Additionally, the EBC would like to thank Pat Sullivan for his efforts in organizing the event this year. And let's not forget the members of our local law enforcement; Officers Lowe and Harter of the EPD and Trooper Otolski of the IN State Police. Without them, it would be a very difficult

proposition to host this event. Did you make it out the Memorial Day ride? Sadly, I missed it this year. I heard that the turnout was tremendous, and all enjoyed the USA route.

I think I saw that over 50 riders were in attendance. Now I'm sure that the weather won't be quite a favorable on July 4th, but that route will be on the calendar again come July. If you were able to make it out last week, please think about joining again on the 4th and bring a friend or two. If you've not done that route before, you are missing out and should consider hopping in. It's a great time!

Last month, I talked a bit about the annual "iCan Bike" Day Camp hosted by the Evansville Rehabilitation Center. I wanted to remind folks that this is a favored event for the EBC, one that is close to our hearts. The Bike Camp is a program that teaches individuals with disabilities how to ride a bicycle. The camp uses adapted bicycles and specialized equipment to help participants learn the necessary skills, and volunteers provide one-on-one support to ensure that each participant is successful.


