## July 2023 Ride Notes

We have added some new rides to the schedule. Hopefully the new slower riders can come there and find out what the club is all about and feel safe and build some camaraderie and comfort. We would love to also see you at the Saturday morning rides as there are groups of assorted speeds there. **Wednesday nights at 6:00 and Sunday mornings at 9:00** we will be riding circles in **Wesselman Park** for about an hour. You can stop as needed and ride your own pace. These are great rides for kids also as the area is safe, flat, and biker friendly. We usually park on the left side just after going straight at the split, near the shelter. Hopefully some seasoned riders will also come to show you around and offer pointers as wanted.

**Saturday July 1** is the annual ride to New Albany. This is a great training ride for RAIN. It is 120 miles, one way, and hilly. You must have your own support person and ride home from New Albany.

**Monday July 3** is the **Full Moon** ride this month. The moon rises at 9 so the ride is starting at **8:30 pm**. Hopefully you can still make the morning ride on the 4<sup>th</sup>.

There will be a **Hosted ride on July 4! 9:00 AM at Darmstadt Post Office**. Special USA route. 23 miles. Wear your red, white, and blue jerseys to show our support for the USA. No evening ride is offered. Enjoy the fireworks.

Our **Saturday** rides are all over the place! Morning rides are at **9:00** and afternoon rides **start at 1:00**. Distances listed are the long route. We can help identify short cuts if needed for some riders.

Saturday **July 1** the 9AM ride is at Korner Inn in Elberfeld for 21 or 30 miles. The afternoon ride is at Elite Fitness at 1:00. This is also the annual Ride to New Albany ride day. You must have your own ride home if you go on this one way ride which starts at 7:00 AM.

Our **July 8** ride is at Hawg 'N Sauce in Mt. Vernon for a 30 mile route at 9:00. The afternoon ride will be at Dogtown at 1:00

**July 15** ride is at Hornville Tavern in the morning at 9:00 for 29 miles and at Elite Fitness in the afternoon at 1:00. The big ride of the day is the RAIN ride from Terre Haute to Richmond, IN.

Saturday **July 22** we are at Silver Bell in St. Wendell at 9:00 for 28 miles and Dogtown at 1:00. This is also the day of the Saturday July Club Century ride. See below for details.

Saturday **July 29** ride is back at 9 at Korner Inn in Elberfeld for 21 or 30 miles. The afternoon ride is at Elite Fitness at 1:00.

**Thursday evening rides** are at Reitz High School this month and start at the usual 6:00 pm.
